Vandalism Policy

The Board of Directors /trustees requests that the community cooperate in reporting any incidents of vandalism of charette property and the names of the person or persons believed to be responsible.

School administrators shall prepare a detailed report of any vandalism or injury or damage to school property, including damage to a school building furniture, equipment, or other property.

School administration may submit a copy of the said report to the local police department.

School administrators shall also determine appropriate disciplinary action for students determined to be responsible for vandalism or theft of school property.

A. Damage to School Property

Parent or guardians of any student who damages any school property whether fences, gates, trees or shrubs, or any building or any part thereof or break any window glass or liable or destroy books instruments apparatus, or furniture belonging to the school/ Charette shall be liable to pay in full for all the damages.

B. Graffiti Removal

It shall be the policy of the board of directors/Trustees that school staff will inspect the exterior of the daily and will report incidents to Paolino Properties. every attempt shall be made to remove or cover graffiti as soon as possible.
